



PMH Pain Clinic Opens in Benton City


PMH Pain Clinic has been designed in collaboration with Kadlec Clinics and Kadlec Neuroscience to fill a need in the community to provide medical pain management services. The clinic specializes in the management of medication for those suffering from chronic pain conditions.

Kadlec Primary Care opens in Prosser



With a desire to continue learning, he graduated from UC Davis in 2000 as a Physician's Assistant and has been caring for patients ever since. In 2012, Miguel was honored as the Latino Leader in Medicine by the Professional Latin American Association. PMH Family Medicine welcomes Miguel Medrano to the team of providers in Benton City.
